

What if a disaster strikes while you're driving?
Essential disaster preparedness tips for drivers.

Car Emergency Preparedness Guide

- Avoid sudden turns or braking. If possible, safely pull to the left side of the road.
- Once stopped, listen to the radio for disaster and traffic updates, and act based on the information and your surroundings.
- Whenever possible, park your car off the road to avoid blocking emergency vehicles or evacuees.
- If you need to evacuate and leave your car behind, do your best to park it off the road.

Important Tips for Leaving Your Car on the Road

1. Pull over to the left side of the road.
2. Turn off your engine.
3. Make sure the engine can be started again. (In case the car is blocking traffic and needs to be moved.)
4. Make sure the windows are firmly shut.
5. Do not leave any valuables in the car.
6. Do not lock the doors.
7. Leave a note with your contact information on the dashboard.

Free Emergency Wi-Fi 00000JAPAN Can Be Used During Natural Disasters

Free Wi-Fi "00000JAPAN" (Five Zero Japan)
is a public netwo
for disasters.

Turn **Wi-Fi on** in your computer or phone settings.

Select "**00000JAPAN**" from the list of available networks.

Before connecting, take precautions!

- The network does not require authentication, so avoid entering personal information (e.g., for online banking or shopping) due to security risks.
- Note that "00000JAPAN" is accessible only near public Wi-Fi spots, so proximity to a hotspot is required.
- After use, disconnect from the network to minimize security concerns.

This service is activated during major natural disasters, like earthquakes,
when phone lines become overloaded.
